## Guidelines for Bands Performing at MSHSAA Football Playoff Contests

Half-time intermission shall be limited to a maximum of 15 minutes ( 12 minutes max for one band) plus the 3 minute warm-up prior to the start of the second half ( 20 minutes if both bands are performing; 7 minutes each band).

Option 1 - One Band Performing: The band performance shall be limited to a maximum of $\mathbf{1 2}$ minutes at half-time including marching onto the field, performing, and marching off the field. The band director shall consult the game manager concerning arrangement for half-time and pre-game activities. A schools' dance team may perform during the $\mathbf{1 2}$ minutes allotted the school.

Option 2 - Two Bands Performing: Each band performance shall be limited to a maximum of 7 minutes at half-time including marching onto the field, performing, and marching off the field. The band director shall consult the game manager concerning arrangements for hall-time and pre-game activities. A school's dance team may perform during the $\mathbf{7}$ minutes allotted each school.

Schools will be expected to follow the information in 'Guidelines for Band during Regular Season Contest' regarding when to play during the contest.

NOTE: Contact should be made with the host school if a pep band is coming to perform at any MSHSAA playoff game. This will avoid confusion and performance issues at the site.
