Perfect Games

The earliest perfect shooting game on record was recorded on Feb. 4, 2003 by sophomore David Nurse of Kearney in his team's 72-58 win at Ruskin. Nurse was 8-for-8 from the field, including a perfect 5-for-5 effort from three-point range and was also 10-for-10 at the free throw line contributing to a 31-point effort in the contest.

Poplar Bluff standout Tyler Hansbrough also had a perfect shooting game on January 18, 2004 in the Third-Place Game of the Bass Pro Tournament of Champions at Hammons Student Center on the campus of Missouri State University in Springfield. The junior went 12-for-12 from the field (including 2-for-2 from beyond the arc) and 9-for-9 from the free throw line in the contest against Kickapoo. He finished with 35 points, 13 rebounds and 5 assists.

Matt Fouch of LaPlata went 10-for-10 from the field, including 6-for-6 from three-point range, in a game at Bucklin on Dec. 8, 2006.

Layne Fischer of Warrensburg was a perfect 11-for-11 from the field on Dec. 27, 2010 against Salem in the Rolla Tournament. Fischer finished the game with 22 points.
