

4. **District Scheduling.** Each school shall enter into a two-year, home and home contract with all other schools in the assigned district. All district contests shall be played on the last playing dates of the regular season.
- A) Each school in a district must play all other schools in that district. District games shall take precedence over non-district games in terms of scheduling. The entire district schedule must be set before contracts for non-district games are finalized.
- B) If the district teams cannot agree by majority vote, on a district schedule, each team will draw a number and the schedule shall be drawn as follows. (The second year's schedule would be identical with the exception of reversing home and away contests).

- C) District Contest Arrangements: All district contests will be administered by the participating schools. The MSHSAA will not be involved until the post-district (sectional, quarterfinal, semifinal and final) contests. Participating schools shall hire officials, set ticket prices, establish guarantees, etc., for all district contests. This shall be done in writing.
