* **Nov. 15, 1915** - Sikeston topples Kennett, 147-0

* **Oct. 4, 1919** - Sikeston defeats Caruthersville, 148-0, establishing a southeast Missouri scoring record that still stands.

* **Sept. 29, 1921** - St. Louis University High downs Belleville Township (Ill.), 83-0 behind 12 team rushing touchdowns and 11 PAT's by Tom Stanton.

* **1922 Season** - St. Louis University High allows just 6 points in 5 games played.

* **November 1923** - Moberly beats Montgomery City 148-0. Moberly back Appleton rushes for 12 touchdowns and kicks 16 extra points to account for 88 of his team's tallies. This is long considered the state team and individual scoring records.

* **1924 Season** - SLUH's defense grabs headlines, allowing 12 points in 7 games.
