the best team ever? . . .

Before the MSHSAA football playoffs began in 1968, a team from Valle Catholic High School in Ste. Genevieve put together one of the most impressive seasons ever achieved by an American prep squad.

Aside from going undefeated in 1966, the Warriors did not allow a single point, posting 10 shutouts in as many efforts, while accumulating 535 points. Both the team's scoring average per game (53.5) and points allowed per game (0.0) are Missouri records.
