Five Categories of Evaluation:

1. **Knowledge of and Adherence to the MSHSAA Scholar Bowl Rules:** Knowing the rules and officiating the match as per those rules without fail.
2. **Game Management:** Assertive yet professional management of the game and the teams. Having a good attitude and general enthusiasm for the game. An ability to resolve protests quickly and fairly by balancing the necessary use of authority with sufficient humility to admit a mistake.
3. **Pacing and Intonation:** Reading with a consistent rhythm which is maintained throughout the question. Proper emphasis and inflection throughout each sentence and each question; communicating the question as a meaningfully spoken phrase, rather than as a series of words to be pronounced.
4. **Pronunciation:** Basic spoken command of college-level vocabulary, familiarity with quiz bowl terminology, and ability to quickly and effectively incorporate pronunciation guides into the reading of a question.
5. **Expertise:** Evidence of a working knowledge of one or more major categories (science, math, history, etc.) to help ensure that at least a majority of questions are being read accurately.

Rating Scale: 1 = **Outstanding:** Fully meets or exceeds the expectations of this category
 2 = **Above Average:** Skill in this category is appropriate for State Level
 3 = **Average or Neutral:** Barely satisfactory in this category or no opinion or unable to rate
 4 = **Below Average:** Needs improvement in this category; skill not appropriate for state level
 5 = **Insufficient/Poor:** Negative traits in this specific category; improvement unlikely
