NFHS Online Sanctioning Process

The NFHS has moved to an online sanctioning process. Interested individuals who plan to host an event will go online at the NFHS website (www.nfhs.org), register as an event manager (if you have not already done so), create an event and fill out the online application. An e-mail is then sent to the host school's principal and host state association. The state association reviews the application online including the list of invited schools and determines if the event will be approved or denied. Once approved the event sponsor is notified that payment is required. **Credit card and electronic check are the only forms of payment accepted.** Once payment is received by the NFHS, the invited states/schools are notified and the event is listed on the NFHS website. As the invited states respond to the sanction it is automatically updated on the NFHS website. Once every invited state has responded, the application is approved for sanctioning by the NFHS staff.

The processing fee structure has changed for the 2010-11 school year. Please refer to Appendix D of the 2010-11 MSHSAA Official Handbook for NFHS Sanctioning Procedures or go to the NFHS website.

The NFHS has placed a link on their website called 'New Online NFHS Sanctioning Process for Event Managers and School Sponsors'. It does an excellent job of highlighting this new change and provides an FAQ section that will be helpful to everyone.
