



2010 GIRLS STATE MEET FINALS – SPECTATOR ENTRY TO STANDS

Due to the strong interest in the preferred seating in the spectator stands, and the limited space available in the Rec-Plex lobby and connecting areas for spectators to congregate and “wait”, the following procedure will be followed for entry into the spectator stands for Session 3: Swimming Finals.

How to receive a SPECTATOR SEATING ENTRY number

- Beginning on Saturday morning at 8:00am, when Swimming Finals Tickets go on sale, and AFTER purchasing a ticket for Session 3: Swimming Finals, you may request an ‘Entry Number’. Individuals who have purchased one or more pre-sale tickets from the MSHSAA office must come to the Rec-Plex and request an ‘Entry Number’ in order to enter the stands prior to general admission.
- Individuals coming to the Rec-Plex prior to 8:00am to wait for sales to begin will be lined up outside the front entrance under the canopy. Diving spectators who arrive early will be lined up separately.
- Each individual that is holding a Swimming Finals ticket may receive ONLY ONE ‘Entry Number’ (while available). (Example: One person that is holding two tickets may only receive ONE Entry Number.)
- A maximum of 400 Entry Numbers will be handed out.
- Those receiving an Entry Number may not line-up at the admission gate doors prior to them opening.
- After receiving your number, you may sit in the food court, main lobby, ice arena or leave the building if you wish. There is a separate admission charge to the Rec-Plex if you wish to work out, use the gymnasium or ice skate.
- ***Please be aware that it is your responsibility to be in the Rec-Plex once the diving competition has ended.*** (Although we cannot predict the ending time of the diving competition, we strongly recommend that you make sure you are in the Rec-Plex by 1:00pm)

Procedure for entering the spectator stands for the Swimming Finals

As we open the spectator stands for the Swimming Finals, we will make the following five announcements in five minute intervals. If you are not present when the four groups with numbers are called, you will have to enter the bleachers at the end of the line with those who do not have a number.

1. Numbers 1-100 are allowed to enter the spectator stands (***in any order***)
2. Numbers 101-200 are allowed to enter spectator stands (***in any order***)
3. Numbers 201-300 are allowed to enter spectator stands (***in any order***)
4. Numbers 301-400 are allowed to enter spectator stands (***in any order***)
5. Anyone without a number can enter the spectator stands (***in line order***)

For those who do not receive an Entry Number

- Those not receiving a number may line-up at the admission gate doors.
- Those waiting in line may stand or sit on the ground, but chairs are **NOT** allowed.
- The Rec-Plex staff will advise you if it is necessary for you to move or change locations; it is imperative that walkways are kept clear.
- Saving spaces in line is prohibited.
