CLINIC FORMAT

The MSHSAA will once again be sponsoring One Day Cheer Clinics this summer at 8 different sites throughout the state. Universal Cheerleaders Association (UCA) will provide 10 talented, experienced and professional instructors to conduct these clinics. These enthusiastic instructors will provide an exciting and educational clinic experience for cheerleaders of all levels.

Updated instruction to be taught at the clinic will include new and usable cheers and sidelines, in addition to a fun 8-count dance. There will also be instruction on how to properly stunt using progressions. The dance class and partner stunts class will be 2 tier sessions based upon the skill level of each squad.

The program format will feature 2 coaches' sessions. The first session will be a coaches' roundtable discussion led by a UCA instructor. Topics will be selected based on those submitted by the coach on the registration form. The second session will be "Cheerleading Sports Medicine" conducted by an athletic trainer. This year's session will cover "Emergency Action Planning and Injury Prevention: Basic Wrapping and Taping". This will be a hands-on session so coaches will need to bring a roll of pre-wrap, tape and scissors to the session as none will be provided on site.

The MSHSAA One Day Cheer Clinics provide school cheerleaders an affordable clinic experience with excellent instruction. The UCA instructors will motivate your cheerleaders and get them off to a great start for the summer. Come join in the fun and excitement!





ABOUT THE CLINICS

Each clinic will begin at 9:00 AM and finish at 3:30 PM, with an hour scheduled for lunch. The clinic pre-registration fee is \$25 per student, which includes a MSHSAA cheer t-shirt. Please complete the size when submitting your registration form. Faculty coaches are admitted free. Coaches are welcome to attend the coaches' sessions at no charge, even if their cheerleaders are unable to attend.

Due to the warm weather that generally prevails this time of year, it is recommended that all cheerleaders wear appropriate attire (i.e. shorts, athletic shoes) as some facilities may not run their air conditioning during the summer months. Lunch will not be provided, so students should bring a sack lunch or make other arrangements.

All materials taught will be new and will NOT be taught at other UCA Summer Camps. Each school will receive a DVD of all the material taught at the clinic. However, the easier version of the material taught to the younger squads will NOT be on the DVD. We suggest that you bring a pencil and paper for additional notes. This will be especially helpful in stunt class since no video taping of the UCA instructors teaching will be permitted.

Pre-registrations must be postmarked by May 5, 2017. All registrations postmarked after May 5th shall be \$30. *Walk-in registrations* shall be invoiced to the school at \$30 per participant. *No* payments will be accepted at the clinic site as schools will be billed directly by MSHSAA.
