## **Baseball Advisory Committee Recommendations**

June 12, 2025

1. Recommend to the NFHS the request for experimental use of one-way communication devices from the dugout to the pitcher and catcher. (7-0)

Rationale: One-way communication between the coach and both players will allow for a faster pace of play.

\*\*\* 2. Recommend language to be added to Section 3.C (Postseason) in the Baseball manual that reads: All host sites must provide a minimum of It is recommended that host sites provide two bullpens that are equal in quality and accessibility for both teams. Each bullpen should feature a mound with proper game-like slope and configuration to ensure consistency with in-game conditions. If two such bullpens are not available, both teams must have equal access to the superior or single bullpen mound. (7-0)

Rationale: To ensure an equal and competitive environment for a state playoff series game.

3. Recommend to move the district tournament window for Classes 1-4 to begin on Thursday Wednesday of week 45 the MSHSAA standardized calendar. (7-0)

Rationale: Provides greater flexibility to address scheduling conflicts while ensuring the tournament is completed in a timely manner, allowing teams to prepare for the sectional round with consideration for pitching limitations and availability

4. Recommend to move the district tournament window for Classes 5-6 to begin on-Wednesday Monday of week 46 the MSHSAA standardized calendar and to end on Monday Saturday of week 46 of the MSHSAA standardized calendar. Mandatory scheduled start on Tuesday of week 46. (7-0)

Rationale: Provides greater flexibility to address scheduling conflicts while ensuring the tournament is completed in a timely manner, allowing teams to prepare for the quarterfinal round with consideration for pitching limitations and availability.

\* 5. Recommend forming a sub-committee to explore the implementation of a double-elimination format at either the district or state series level. Suggested members include Nathan Gegg, Joe Kinder, Chris Ackman, Zach Dyer, and Michael Calhoun. (7-0)

Rationale: Explore and evaluate the most effective options for implementing a doubleelimination format during the postseason.
