GOLF ADVISORY COMMITTEE Held May 23, 2018

- 1. Recommend that MSHSAA adopts the most current USGA Rules with every USGA publication date/year.
- *** 2. Recommend to change the use of rangefinders as follows:

Golfers and <u>Coaches</u> may use <u>range finders</u> distance measuring devices, <u>and share information</u>, in high school golf that measure distance only. The use of devices that gauge or measure other conditions that might affect a player's play (e.g., wind or gradient) are not permitted. <u>A Cell Phone used as a distance measuring device is prohibited due to the other capabilities of the <u>device</u>.</u>

* 3. Recommend to change the use of Cell Phones as follows:

<u>Cell Phones on the golf course</u>: Golfers may not use electronic communicational devices or equipment on the golf course, <u>except for measuring</u> <u>distances</u>. The penalty may be disqualification. Golfers may have cell phones in their bag to use a cell phone in an emergency situation, to notify authorities.

- 4. Recommend to change the Spectator/Gallery Guidelines to reflect the continued restriction of spectators to the cart path but allow spectators/galleries to remain even with the last player in the group rather than 20yds behind to assist with pace of play.
