## GOLF ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Held May 24, 2023

1. Recommend a change to Section 2-F of the MSHSAA Golf Manual to clarify the restriction of the use of smart watches that are connected to cell phone.

Cell Phones/Smart Watches on the golf course: Golfers may not use or wear any electronic communicational devices or equipment on the golf course. The penalty for misuse is may be disqualification. Golfers may have cell phones or other communication devices in their bag to use in an emergency situation only, to notify authorities.
2. Recommend a change to Section 5-A-8A of the MSHSAA Golf Manual regarding team state qualifying criteria from district to state as follows:

QUALIFIERS: Teams and individuals will qualify from districts to state as follows:
A. TEAMS: The District Champion and Runner-up teams will automatically advance their top four player scores from district tournament play to the state tournament. If a team's fourth and fifth player score is a tie, both players will advance to the state tournament but will not count as part of the top 12 individuals. If a team's fifth player score is within the top 12 individuals OR within +10 strokes of the top 12 individuals cut line, the fifth player will advance to the state tournament but will not count as part of the top 12 individuals.

Note: If a qualifying team's $5^{\text {th }}$ player score places them in the top 12 individuals, then the $5^{\text {th }}$ player is permitted to advance with the other four team members to the state tournament.
Note: If a team's 5 th player score places in the top 12 individuals, they will count as one of the 12 individuals that advance to state.
Note: A school that qualifies 4 or 5 individuals to the state tournament will also be permitted to compete in team competition.
3. Recommend a change to Section 5-A-8B of the MSHSAA Golf Manual regarding individual state qualifying criteria from district to state as follows:
B. INDIVIDUALS: After removing the player scores from qualifying teams (district champion, runner-up), the remaining top 1213 individual player scores, including ties, will advance to the state tournament. Note: If a team's 5 th player places in the top 12 individuals, they will count as one of the 12 individuals that advance to state. When there is a tie for the last individual qualifying position, all individuals tied shall be individual qualifiers to the state tournament.
