Summary of the Speech, Debate, & Theatre Advisory Committee Meeting with Board Action

May 5, 2021

- 1. Recommend that asynchronous event students need to stay on screen, with no editing and with the camera remaining stationary at all times.
- 2. Recommend that during virtual tournaments all event rounds (with the exception of Reader's Theatre and One-Act Play) be synchronous for district and state, only allowing a video back up to account for internet issues.
- 3. Recommend that Policy Debate preparation time be increased to 8 minutes and Public Forum Debate preparation time be increased to 3 minutes to line up with the NSDA permanent change.
- 4. Recommend that the first summary speech times in Public Forum Debate increase from 2 minutes to 3 minutes to align with the NSDA permanent change.
- 5. Recommend expanding the number of events from three to four that a student can enter at the district and state tournaments, with a cap on three Individual Events.
- 6. Recommend expanding the number of events from three to four that a student can enter at the district and state tournaments, with a cap on three Individual Events.
