D. Weight Management Program

1. Proposal to recalculate individual weight loss plans if a weigh-in exceeds the daily minimum weight stated in the management plan (Bradley)
2. Adopt the option to have coaches declare the minimum weight class. (Cooper)
3. Add a coach controlled "Burn Minimum weight class" option in TW OPC (Weight Loss Plan) that allows a team to voluntary lock a wrestlers Minimum Weight Class at a higher class than the assessed minimum when a team and athlete do not intend to use the assessed minimum weight class. (NW)
4. A wrestler may not use any pound allowance (2-lb growth allowance and/or consecutive-day allowance) to weigh in at the upper of the two eligible weight classes listed on the wrestler's weight loss plan unless the wrestler has previously made a scratch weigh-in at the lower eligible weight class. (NW)

NOTE: If the wrestler has not made a prior scratch weigh-in at the lower eligible class, the wrestler must weigh in at scratch for one of the two eligible weight classes on that date (without applying allowances to access the upper class).
