DRESS CODE: Players, coaches, and spectators shall wear appropriate golf attire. Shirts must have collars. Shorts shall be Bermudalength. <u>Jeans and jean shorts are prohibited by players and coaches</u>. **This dress code applies during practice rounds as well as the tournament.** *No metal spikes!*

TOURNAMENT FEES: Tournament fees include practice round, range balls, and green fees for Monday and Tuesday. **Cost:** \$60/player. **Do not pay the Golf Course! MSHSAA will invoice your school for the player fee(s).**

PRACTICE ROUND: Practice rounds are available Tuesday, October 14th thru Sunday, October 19th. Please call the pro shop, after qualifying to schedule your tee time (417-624-1611). Sunday's Practice Round will be tee times. Any rounds outside of this window will be subject to guest fees, including cart. Only one practice round per team/individual is permitted between the District Tournament and the State Tournament. Violating this rule could result in team/individual disqualification. Driving range and putting green will be available all day on Sunday.

COACHES PACKET PICK-UP (NEW): NO coaches meeting – approved school coaches may pick up their team packets on Sunday, October 19th, between 3-5 pm. If you cannot pick up the packet at that time, you may pick up the packet between 7-8 am on Monday. Packets will include coaches' hangtags, all pertinent course information including competition & local course rules.

GOLF SHOP & RANGE HOURS/TEE TIMES: Golf shop and range hours are 7:00 am – dusk. Range is closed after all participants have teed off for the day. Tee times start at 8:30 am on both days of the tournament.

SCORECARDS: Players will be called to the starter's table 10 minutes prior to their tee times. At the starter's table, players receive their scorecards and identify the golf ball with which they will play. (Marked for identification) Players are to report to the designated scoring area immediately upon conclusion of their round. Prior to signing the card, all rules' questions should be resolved. The cards are to be turned into the scorer at the score tables. Please remember that each golfer is responsible for the accuracy of hole play score and not the addition.

LIVE SCORING: One participant from each group will be responsible for entering scores on the MSHSAA Golf app after each hole. Spectators may follow live scoring through the MSHSAA golf app for a fee.

RULES: USGA Rules of Golf shall govern play. Unless weather/course conditions indicate otherwise, the ball will be played "down." An information sheet outlining special course rules or local rules is available on the MSHSAA Golf app. Any changes in conditions or play will be addressed at packet pick-up or through the app.

<u>Player Carts-Practice Round</u>: Carts will be available for players during the practice round on a first come first serve basis. Participants must be at least 16 years of age and possess a valid driver's license to drive a cart. Player cart rental will \$20 per person and must be paid at the time of use. <u>No spectator carts will be rented for the Sunday Practice Round.</u>

SPECTATORS: <u>Digital Tickets may be purchased for \$12/day and can be purchased through the MSHSAA website after district tournament qualification.</u> (This does NOT include the MSHSAA Golf app Live Scoring fee). Spectators check in at the admission table each day to scan their digital ticket and receive a Gallery Pass wristband as well as a copy of the rules and regulations for spectators. Spectator Carts: Carts are only available to spectators who have secured a written request from the school administrator that indicates the medical condition, handicap or disability that results in the need for the fan/spectator to rent a cart. The school administrator will provide the letter of request to the fan/spectator who present the letter to the club pro/state manager for approval for cart rental. Spectator cart rental will be \$40.00/cart with limited cart inventory on a first come first serve basis.

LUNCH: A limited menu for lunch options for players/coaches/spectators. All lunch options on the menu will be \$14. The 19th Hole will also be available for non-alcoholic beverages, continental breakfast and cold deli sandwiches.

SOUVENIR SALES: An assortment of state championship apparel will be available onsite. CASH,CREDIT/DEBIT CARD ONLY.
