DIRECTIONS, PARKING AND SITE INFORMATION

UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI: MEMORIAL UNION

MAP OF UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI CAMPUS: The map of the campus is posted on the MSHSAA website (<u>www.mshsaa.org</u>) under the Scholar Bowl activity area. The Memorial Union is on Hitt Street in the heart of the MU campus, near downtown Columbia – and is the building visible from a distance – with the large castle-like spires. Maps of the building and SCB competition rooms are discussed in the online coaches meeting.

DROP-OFF, PICK-UP AND BUS PARKING INSTRUCTIONS: Busses will need to drop-off students outside of the restricted area by the Union, then park elsewhere. Due to the barriers, the best place to <u>drop-off and pick up</u> is at the SOUTHEAST corner of University Avenue and Hitt Street (this intersection is NORTH of the Union). Parking is discussed in the online coaches meeting.

OTHER VEHICLE PARKING INSTRUCTIONS: If your team is traveling in a personal car or a small van, you may utilize the parking garages near the Union (there will be a fee on Friday, but garages are free on Saturday). The procedures and instructions for arranging FRIDAY parking are discussed in the online coaches meeting.

<u>CHECK-IN & TEAM PACKETS</u>: You should come to Memorial Union North (North side of the Archway of the Union) to the middle Stotler Ballroom (2nd room on the left) to check-in and receive your team packet. 



PLEASE NOTE: Each round of the tournament shall begin at the designated time. Teams not ready to compete at the designated time will forfeit. A forfeit will be determined by the judges in the room where the team arriving late is scheduled to compete. The only exception will be if the late arriving team's preceding game was an overtime game, to the extent that the team was unable to report to its next game. This should not occur because the time schedule of the tournament has been designed to allow for overtime games.

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU

At least FOUR rostered players: You must have four team members available to start a game and to play at all times.

Proper Uniforms: Uniforms are not required, but you certainly look nice when team members are matching. Just make sure you abide by the specifications in the rules in regard to attire and prohibited attire (such as hats, etc.).

Writing Utensils: You must provide your own writing utensils.

Not needed:

Buzzer systems: MSHSAA will provide buzzer systems for the State Championships. If you would like to bring yours as a <u>back-up</u>, that would be fine but please remember to take it back home. Each year, a couple get left behind.

Nameplates: MSHSAA will provide nameplates for your team for the State Championships. The 10 names will come from your Quarterfinal Roster.

Scratch paper: Moderators will pass out paper prior to each game.

Put away or do not bring:

Cell phones and smart watches: Please store all electronic devices away from players and keep them silenced.

FOOD OPTIONS

Arrange Ahead and EAT BEFORE:

We would suggest you call ahead and make arrangements for food/meals in advance of arriving in Columbia. You will need to EAT BEFORE your team checks in at the Union. The schedule has changed and you need to have eaten lunch <u>before</u> your first game. Note: The MU Campus does not accept cash.


