MSHSAA STATE SWIMMING EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION ON SITE: Instructions and procedures will be communicated to participants and fans by one or all of the following means:

Instructions from tournament staff via Bull Horn Instructions from Officials via mobile radios Air Horn (3 horns) – immediate evacuation of facility to secure outdoor location

HAZARDOUS WEATHER:

Tornado: Deck will be evacuated to the pass gate hallway outside the locker rooms. The

Rec-Plex staff will direct the evacuation of the upper stands.

Earthquake: Evacuate all indoor facilities; move to open outdoor area.

FIRE OR ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD: Evacuate area of hazard to minimum of 300 feet.

EMERGENCY EVENT INFORMATION: Should the entire site be evacuated for any reason, information concerning the State Event and its status and schedule will be distributed through one or all of the following outlets:

TRAINERS, LIFEGUARDS & EMERGENCY SERVICES

There will be a trainer on site throughout competition. The trainer will be located near the leisure slide by the south glass doors. The school coach and parent(s), if present, will determine if emergency care is needed. An ambulance shall be summoned if necessary or requested. Lifeguards will also be on duty throughout the meet and will be stationed around the vicinity of the competition pool, the warm-up pool and the diving boards. Please allow these individuals to do their jobs without distraction.
