

OFF-CAMPUS DRAMA SITE – SPRINGFIELD CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL

ONE-ACT PLAYS (Main Stage)

1. Main-Stage has a proscenium opening of 35 feet wide. The stage is 21 feet deep. There is one traveler located roughly 6 feet behind the grand drape. The grand drape covers the 35 foot proscenium opening. Stage Left wing space is 8ft. by 17ft. Stage Right wing space is 8ft. by 17ft. The theatre seats 260 people.
2. There is one 83 inch tall by 24 inch wide door at the back of the theatre. Therefore, schools will have to load and unload through the front of the house. There are two 57 inch wide by 83 inch tall entrances located at the front of the house. Schools should unload on the West side (football field entrance) of the high school and will have to carry down the hallway into the front of the house to get to the stage.
3. NO pyrotechnic are permitted. This includes but not limited to, torches, flash pots, sparklers, or anything else that creates flame or sparks. Hazers and Theatrical smoke machines may be used. There is not a fan available to contestants. Competitors will need to provide their own power extension cords.
4. The use of firearms on stage is at the discretion of the Stage Manager and the school Administration. Guns may be allowed if the gun is a blank firing gun and the gun is shown and demonstrated to the Stage Manager prior to the performance.
5. There will be one outsource made available through the soundboard to connect a laptop to run your sound. Springfield Catholic only has one free standing microphone available.
6. The lighting system is a Computer Hog 4 Lighting System and there are 2 LED spots that can be controlled by a separate technician.
7. Men's and Women's restrooms will be available and accessible outside of the house. These restrooms will be usable by other Springfield Catholic High School students during the school day. When not performing please be respectful of the ongoing performing school and nearby classes.
8. There are not any headsets for backstage communication or in the light/sound booth. The light and sound booth is located in the back of the house above the house/stage.
9. If schools have special needs or questions, they should inform us with their entry as well as contact Springfield Catholic Theatre's Site Manager, via email, as soon as possible.
