St. Louis University High School Athletic Director

The Athletic Director at St. Louis University High School oversees and administers all interscholastic athletic programs, including club sports, in accordance with the philosophy, policies, rules and regulations of St. Louis University High School, the Missouri State High School Activities Association (M.S.H.S.A.A), and any other governing bodies for our sports programs. The Athletic Director also communicates the overall vision for the department, one that is consistent with the Mission of St. Louis University High and the Jesuit charism of the school. This vision needs to be embodied in the department's hiring and dismissal practices, supervision and evaluation, and mentoring of head coaches. The Athletic Director acts as the voice of the department and a representative of the school in communication with parents, alumni and media.

On an administrative level, the Athletic Director must oversee the daily scheduling, transportation and facilities needs of all teams and programs in the department. Such oversight includes responsibilities such as:

- Acts as the school's liaison with M.S.H.S.A.A.
- In conjunction with head coaches, develops and manages budgets for each program in accordance with the school's budgeting process and submits these, as well as a budget for the Athletic department itself, to the Principal and the Vice President, Administration.
- Maintains an inventory and record of all equipment and uniforms and coordinates the storage and repair of athletic equipment.
- Works with the Director of Facilities in the scheduling and administering SLUH athletic events and camps, as well as the care and use of the gym and stadiums.
- Manages the hiring and the assignment of officials for home athletic contests.
- Requests eligibility lists for all teams and distributes these lists to the appropriate school and state officials.
