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VIDEO TAPING

Specifically, I would refer you and your coaching staff to Item K, page 18-19, of the MSHSAA Wrestling Manual which spells out the details of videotaping wrestling contests.

The following procedures will be used at the Mizzou Arena. No video tapes will be collected. In addition, there will be no reserved section for videotaping in the Mizzou Arena and the following restrictions will apply:

- 1. Anyone may videotape from anywhere in the seating area;
- 2. Only a "stick" may be used to support the camera, no tripods;
- 3. No electricity will be available;
- 4. No videotaping may be done in the isles nor may equipment be left in the bleachers.

Administrators are asked to share this information with not only your coaching staff but also with parents who may desire to videotape. Should there be any questions concerning the videotaping policy, please contact our office.

SIGNS AND BANNERS

Based on the history of issues with banners at the MSHSAA State Wrestling Championships and disrespect to the arena staff, the MSHSAA Wrestling Advisory Committee supports the MSHSAA and Mizzou Arena staff in prohibiting the hanging of banners at the MSHSAA State Wrestling Championships beginning on February 19, 2015 at the 2015 MSHSAA State Championships.
