



Available Percussion Instruments And Equipment for State Music

The following equipment will be available at the Festival. If you need anything **not listed**, **bring your own or make your own arrangements to borrow from other groups**. The University of Missouri or MSHSAA will not supply instruments for solos, except piano solos and percussion solos and ensembles using the instruments listed below. The percussion equipment may be moved between the rooms by the performers depending upon their needs. ***There will be one 5 octave marimba placed in A.P. Green Chapel and it cannot be moved to the other performance centers.***

- Music stands will be available in all instrumental performance rooms.
- A piano will be available in all performance rooms – some may be electronic pianos. **There is no guarantee a piano bench will be provided.** There will be a chair to sit on.
- **Percussion Equipment Supplied:** Please note the keyboard instruments may be moved between the Stotler Rooms for performances as needed.
 - **Memorial Union North Stotler 1:** One bass drum, one set of chimes, four timpani (32", 29", 26", 23"), one low A (4.3) marimba, one low E (4.6) marimba, one low C (5.0) marimba, one xylophone, one vibraphone.
 - **Memorial Union North Stotler 3:** One bass drum, one set of chimes, four timpani (32", 29", 26", 23"), one, low A (4.3) marimba, one low C (5.0) marimba, one xylophone, one vibraphone.
 - **A.P Green Chapel (South Memorial Union):** One low C (5.0) marimba. **This marimba cannot be moved to either Stotler Room.**

Note: No mallets or beaters are furnished. Equipment may be moved between the performance rooms throughout the day so please check the other rooms to locate what you may need prior to your performance time.
