

Updated Information for MU Visitor Parking Locations

Please Note: All reserved and restricted spaces are enforced 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Please be aware that some metered parking adjacent to the MU campus is enforced by the City of Columbia. See page 2 of this document for information regarding downtown parking options.

TWO-DAY PARKING PERMIT FOR MSHSAA 2023

This special permit gives access for a 2-day parking permit in Hitt Street Parking Structure, Except Level 6, for April 27 & April 28, 2023. No physical permit is required upon registration.

HITT STREET PARKING STRUCTURE PARKING: Registration on the above link will provide a virtual permit, which will be honored in all spaces in Hitt Street Parking Structure, except level 6. During the MSHSAA Music Festival, enforcement on Levels 1-5 is M – F, 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Level 6 is reserved and enforced 24 hours a day/seven days a week.

ACCESSIBILITY PARKING: Visitors using accessible spaces must: 1) Register on the above link, which provides a virtual permit. Virtual permits are required in all spaces in Hitt Street Parking Structure for the MSHSAA Music Festival M-F 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. 2) have state-issued placard (or license plate) displayed. Other non-visitors using accessible spaces during regular enforcement hours must 3) provide a copy of the placard and DMV receipt with placard number to muparking@missouri.edu. 4) Register on the above link, which provides a virtual permit. Virtual permits are required in all spaces in Hitt Street Parking Structure for the MSHSAA Music Festival M-F 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. If an accessible space is used during non-enforcement hours, display state-issued placard (or license plate). Outside enforcement hours, no permit or meter payment is required. Please read the signs at the lot entrances, and signs at specific parking spaces.

ADDITIONALLY, METERED PARKING IS AVAILABLE IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS: Payment is required for metered spaces. Temporary or visitor virtual permits are not allowed in metered lots outside Hitt Street Parking Structure during the MSHSAA Music Festival. Parkeon machines accept coins, currency, and credit cards. They recognize only full hours, and do not give change. Meters are enforced M – F, 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. The FlowBird application can be used as an alternate method to pay Parkeon meter machines. Visitors using metered accessible spaces outside of Hitt Street Parking Structure must pay the meter and must have a state-issued placard (or license plate) displayed if parking during the MSHSAA Music Festival. See “ACCESSIBILITY PARKING” above.

Hitt Street Visitor Lot: Located directly north of MU Student Center. Enter from Hitt Street. Only metered parking is available. Parkeon machines accept coins, currency, and credit cards. Temporary or visitor virtual permits are not valid in this lot.

Memorial Union Visitor Lot: Located directly east of Memorial Union. Enter from University Avenue. Metered parking only. Temporary or visitor virtual permits are not allowed in this lot.

Lot CG17: Located at the southeast corner of Rollins Street and Tiger Avenue. Metered parking only. Parkeon machines accept coins, currency, and credit cards. Temporary or visitor virtual permits are not allowed in this lot.

Lot WG10: Located on the west side of the intersection of 5th Avenue and Conley Avenue. Metered Parking only. Temporary or visitor virtual permits are not allowed in this lot.

RESTRICTED PARKING - STAFF AND RESIDENCE HALL LOTS: Parking is restricted in staff and residence hall parking lots and structures. Residence hall lots are enforced 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Violators may be ticketed and towed. Each lot or structure has signage at the entrance indicating the hours of enforcement. Some staff lots near Faurot Field are restricted during home football games. Please read the signs at the lot entrances, and any signs at specific parking spaces. Parking restrictions at the Tiger Avenue Parking Structure, Parking Structure 7, and Lots CG1, CG15, RC1, and WC2, are enforced 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Parking restrictions on Level 6 in Hitt Street Parking Structure are enforced 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

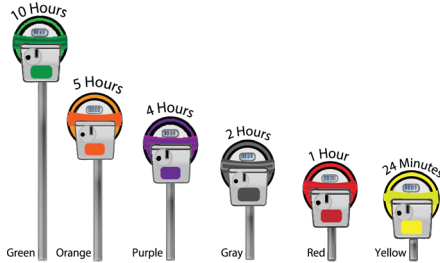
